A WORD FROM OUR PASTOR:



Well, it's beginning to look (and feel) a lot like Christmas! Christmas shopping, special events, family gatherings, getting Christmas cards ready to send, decorating the house (inside and outside)—the whole works have arrived. During this "happiest time of the year", if we're not careful, we can become irritated and frustrated. Even though we know our focus should be on celebrating the birth of our Savior, Jesus Christ, it's so easy to get distracted by many things and forget to stay connected with, and focused on, the one thing that really matters.

In Luke 10:41-42, Jesus told Martha that she'd lost her focus on what matters most - spending time with the Lord. Martha was so bent on planning the perfect dinner party and completing her tasks; she was too distracted to take time to enjoy the company of Jesus. Her sister Mary chose to sit at the feet of Jesus and learn from Him.

Martha's pursuit of perfection left her frustrated with her sister Mary's lack of help to make things "just right." When Martha voiced her irritation to Jesus, He gently reminded her that she was worried about things that didn't matter in the big picture. "But the Lord said to her, "My dear Martha, you are worried and upset over all these details! There is only one thing worth being concerned about. Mary has discovered it....." (vv.41-42) Jesus wasn't bothered with how fancy dinner was, or how clean her kitchen was, or if she had a perfectly decorated home. What really mattered to Jesus was Martha spending time with Him.

Just as Martha took her focus away from Jesus, the same can happen to us very easily in the fast pace of the holidays. The key to a more enjoyable Christmas is to make sure you stop and look at your "to do" list. Is your list crammed full of what you think is important, or what God thinks is important? Are you worried and bothered about things that really don't matter that much?

Despite what the world says, Jesus really is the reason for the season. Take time every day to get alone with Him. Read His Word and talk to Him from your heart. You will be amazed at how your stress level will be replaced with perfect peace as you keep Christ first and foremost in your Christmas.
